• Course Description

Research and Academic Writing Method (RAAWM) provides an undergraduate course to learn most basic/common tools and methods in research and technical writing. First, an introduction on the importance and necessity of learning the RAAWM is presented. Then, the details of the subject in three parts of Research, documentation, and Presentation are explained.

Topics given in this course are the simplified/summarized of the same topics in the similar course in postgraduate study. After successful completion of this course, the students will learn the basic skills of doing an effective search, writing a proposal, doing successful research, writing a technical report, as well as an academic presentation.

Course Project

- 1- Learning the most common subjects and skill of an academic research method and technical writing,
- 2- Capability to write a simple proposal in a given research topic,

- 4- Capability to write a short technical paper on a research subject,
- 5- Capability to have a short presentation in a meeting.
